PURPOSE

This policy establishes the guidelines and procedures for dismissing a student from a UBC Training Centre for academic or behavioural reasons. This policy demonstrates the career college's commitment to upholding standards of academic excellence and maintaining a safe and supportive learning environment for all students.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all students enrolled in programs at UBC Training Centres and outlines the conditions for academic and behavioural dismissals.

POLICY

Academic Dismissal:

1. A student may be dismissed from the college for consistently failing to meet the academic requirements of their program.
2. Students will receive warnings and support before academic dismissal, including meetings with academic advisors and access to tutoring services.

Behavioural Dismissal:

1. A student may be dismissed from the UBC Training Centre for engaging in behaviour that violates the Student Code of Conduct, UBC Training Centre policies or procedures or puts others at risk.
2. Behavioural dismissal may result from repeated disciplinary infractions or a severe single code of conduct, policy or procedure violation.

PROCEDURE

The procedure for dismissal will follow that outlined in the Disciplinary Action Policy
